

HARDWICK RECYCLING CENTER – SWAP SHED DROP-OFF

BEGINNING AUGUST 19TH, 2020

We are pleased to inform you that beginning on August 19th, 2020 the Hardwick Recycling Center will begin accepting items for the Swap Shed. In an abundance of caution, we will be quarantining all items for a minimum of one week, before placing them in the swap shed. Please note that the Swap Shed will be opening once it is deemed safe to do so. There will be additional guidance issued for the use of the Swap Shed at that time.

The process for dropping items off is as follows:

The location to drop off items is at the third garage bay. There will be marked spaces at six feet apart as you wait in line. You are asked to make sure that items are clearly visible for staff to inspect prior to accepting the item(s) from you. Any items that are not acceptable will be returned to you before leaving.

We must be mindful of parking lot safety, as it is likely other patrons may be waiting in line outside the office window purchasing their recycling stickers. At the same time, it is likely there will be vehicles driving through to exit the facility from the upper lot. Therefore, there will be no parking at the garage bay for drop-off. Staff and volunteers will be outside to assist you in parking and maintaining a safe flow of traffic throughout the site. In addition, staff/volunteers can provide you with a cart to transport the items from your vehicle to the garage bay if needed.

As a reminder, the Recycling Center will not accept the following items:

Please note that acceptable items will be determined at the discretion of staff for any items not listed above.

Remember, we will not take any items that appear to be damaged in any way, not limited too; cracked, chipped, rusted, stained or broken.
